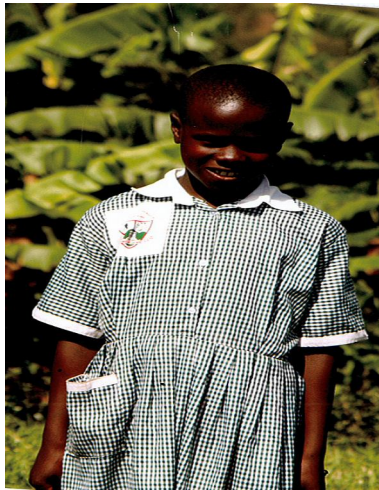


Working with Christian Partners in Africa, we at Billingham Church of England Primary School are sponsoring a girl who lives in Uganda so that she can attend school and get an education.

The girl we are sponsoring is called Atuhaire Praise. She was born in 2001. We do not know her exact date of birth. Atuhaire has a mum called Musinguzi, a brother called Namara and a sister called Twinobusingye.

They live in a village called Rukungiri and the money that we give means that Atuhaire can attend the local primary school, St Paul's Community Primary School.

We look forward to receiving correspondence from Atuhaire and our children will be writing to her, telling her what life is like at our school.



St Paul's School has about 600 children with classes having between 50 and 60 children in them. Children stay in classes until they pass exams. If they pass these exams at the end of each year then they can go to the next class.
