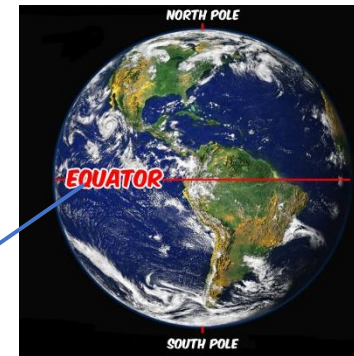


Key Vocabulary	
Climate	Is like the weather over a period of time. It looks at temperature, wind, rainfall, snow.
Rainforest	They are found in warm places, and are full of many tall trees and leafy plants. It's called 'rainforest' because it also gets a lot of rain every year, helping all the plants grow.
Mountain	A mountain is a landform that rises high above its surroundings. Taller than a hill, it usually has steep slopes and a rounded or sharp peak.
Equator	The Equator is an imaginary circle around Earth. It divides Earth into two equal parts between the north and south poles.

- Farming in Brazil. The main crops grown in Brazil are sugarcane, coffee, corn and soya beans.
- There are mountains in the north and south of Brazil.
- Brazil is home to many fascinating animals such as armadillos, tapirs, jaguars and toucans.
