

LANCASTER SPRING TERM OVERVIEW

Maths

This term we will begin by consolidating our work on the first section of fractions. Then we will be looking at our second part of multiplication and division and fractions. We will also be covering decimals and percentages, perimeter and area as well as statistics. As well as continuous revisiting of key skills and multiplication fluency to help support our learning.

PE

This term, Lancasters will be focusing on their skills in dance and dodgeball, then fitness (agility, balance, co-ordination skills, etc.) and finally handball. Our PE lessons are still on Wednesdays and Fridays.

Art and DT

In DT we will be making a mechanical fairground ride, which will include a joint school trip with Typhoons (Y6) to a local windmill to help support knowledge and understanding of gears, pulleys and levers. In art, after half term, we will be creating paper mache sculptures to link with our science topic of Earth and space.

Literacy

In literacy this term we will be looking at Legends and Folklore, specifically looking at Rumaysa (a reimagined take on the traditional tale of Rapunzel) and The Whale – a wordless sea-themed adventure tale.



Science

In science this term we will be learning about solids, liquids and gases, focussing on dissolving and mixing, before moving on to Earth and space.

History / Geography

This term, our historical focus will be on the Battle of Britain. Our geographical focus is on local airfields and geographical skills such as reading OS maps and using an eight-point compass within this topic.

Computing

In our computing lessons this term we will consolidate our work on databases from last term before moving on to using spreadsheets and word processing. We will also be interweaving internet and technology safety, supporting the values of respect and inquisitiveness.

RE

This term, Lancasters will be considering the question of what we mean by religious and spiritual experiences. We will also begin our work on the Archbishop's Young Leaders Award education programme with links to SMSC, British Values, PSHE, Character Education, Citizenship, RE and SIAMS.
