

Geography:

This term Geography will be our main focus. We will be finding out all about Billingham and aim to answer the key question:

What is exciting about Billingham?

The children will say what different buildings and landmarks are in Billingham, create maps, research the Great Fire of Billingham and the River Skirth. Then end by saying how we can keep Billingham tidy.

Art:

In art the children will be creating 3D clay sculptures based on a story character.

ICT:

The children will continue to explore Purple Mash learning to create and follow instructions as well as learn how to do coding. They will finish the term with online bullying and how to manage online information.

Music:

This term the children will be focusing on tempo, pitch and dynamics listening to various pieces of music and applying their skills.

They will also work with Lincolnshire Music Service in Term 4.

PSHE:

This term the children will look at what it's like to be Growing in Our World and Computer Safety (Online bullying, image sharing) They will also look at Race and Ethnicity.

RE:

The children will be answering the question: What do creation stories teach people about God and human nature?

DT:

This term the children will be looking at Materials and making bridges and structures.

Literacy:

During Literacy this term the children will continue their formation of letters and handwriting skills using the Floppy's phonics scheme, Children will have daily vocabulary inputs focussing on 4 new words per week.

In Term 3 the children we will focus on the books 'The odd egg' and 'The comet' writing thought bubbles, short guides, awards, letter of advice, labels, congratulations cards, letters of advice, posters, poems and recipes.



In Term 4 the children will focus on the books 'Dadaji's Paintbrush' and 'Julien is a Mermaid' where they will write labels, captions, character comparisons, thought and speech bubbles, instructions, writing in role, advertisements, notelets and descriptions.

Maths:

The children will continue to follow White Rose Maths starting with Place Value within 20 - understanding all the numbers to 20 and using a range of resources to represent these numbers as well as compare, order and use number lines to 20. They will move on to addition and subtraction and find all the number bonds to 20. They will build on their number and place value knowledge by looking at numbers to 50, counting in 10s and partitioning numbers into tens and ones. At the end of the term they will focus on measurement looking at length and height as well as mass and volume.

PE:

For PE this term the children will be looking at their ball skills practicing their throwing and catching as well as team building skills. They will also look at dance and target games. PE days will be **Monday** and **Tuesday** - children will need to bring their PE kit on **Monday** and will keep it in school till Friday.

Science:

The children will be looking at Everyday Materials which will link to our DT learning where they will use different materials to make a bridge.
