

Maths

We will begin the year with consolidating and expanding our understanding of place value up to 10,000,000. We will then focus on the four operations, fractions and converting units, using problem solving and reasoning to strengthen our understanding of these in various contexts.

English

We will be using 'The Arrival' by Shaun Tan to explore immigration and reasons why people flee their country. We will write a diary entry of the little girl, as well as short scripts for scenes and narrative passages to describe what is happening at certain points in the book. We will continue to focus on grammar, punctuation and spelling to enhance our writing further.

PE

This term, Typhoons will be learning the skills of tennis and netball. We have PE on a Wednesday afternoon and a Friday afternoon. Please be aware that we will be outside for these sessions, so children need suitable PE kits, especially as it begins to cool down.

Computing

We will be exploring microbits and 3D modelling this term, alongside deepening our understanding of online safety. The children will use iPads and laptops to complete activities during lessons.

Science

This term, we will be looking at animals, including humans in science. We will learn about the circulatory system and how our body works to answer the question: What would a journey through our body look like? We will then move on to learning about evolution and think about if we have always looked like we do now. We will be conducting experiments and investigations to help us think scientifically.

RE

Art & Design

History / Geography
