

Maths

This term, we will consolidate our understanding of decimal place value and apply this to rounding up to three decimal places. We will use our knowledge of decimals to multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000 and convert between fractions, decimals and percentages.

We will calculate the area, perimeter and volume of a variety of shapes and record statistics using a range of charts and graphs.

English

We will be developing our own narratives based on the texts: Boy in the Tower and Paradise Sands. We will accurately punctuate direct speech and apply a range of punctuation, sentence structures and cohesive devices to our writing.

We will rehearse and perform a range of our writing orally throughout the term.

Computing

We will be using Purple Mash to deepen our understanding of coding, which we will then apply in order to use a program called Python. The children will use iPads and laptops to complete activities during these lessons. We will continue to focus on online safety throughout the term, in particular online bullying and managing online information.

PE

PE will continue on Wednesday and Thursday afternoons. Pupils will be learning key skills within dance and dodgeball before moving onto handball and fitness after half term.

Science

We will be learning about light: how it travels, how it is reflected and why we need it to see colour. We will apply our knowledge of how light travels to further understand the formation of shadows. We will then investigate the various components of an electrical circuit, recording and analysing our findings before drawing scientific diagrams, with accurate symbols, to represent these circuits.

RE

We will continue to explore the concept of good and evil before moving onto beliefs surrounding caring for the world and others. We will compare and contrast a variety of religions and worldviews and orally discuss our own views and interpretations.

History / Geography

Across the term, we will learn about the Battle of Britain, its important leaders and the events leading up to it. We will understand the importance of the Battle of Britain and Lincolnshire's landscape making it a pivotal role within it. We will explore the significance of Churchill's speech and how the Blitz changed the way of life for many across Great Britain.
