

Key Stage 2 Performance Data for the academic year 2025-26

% of Pupils reaching the Expected Standard

The table below shows the percentage of Year 6 pupils at school who achieved the national expected standard (blue column) against the percentage of pupils nationally reaching the expected standard. The expected standard in reading and maths is a scaled score of 100 or above. The expected standard in writing is a teacher assessment of 'working at the expected standard' or 'working at greater depth'.

% of pupils achieving the higher standard

The table below shows the percentage of pupils achieving the higher standard (blue column) against the percentage of pupils nationally reaching the higher standard. To achieve the higher standard a pupil must have a scaled score of 110 or more in Reading, Maths and GPS. Also working at a greater depth in writing.
